



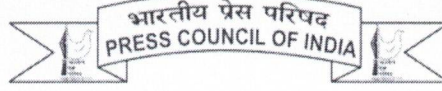

Press Release

The Press Council of India was set up as a quasi-judicial authority in 1966, as an internal self-regulatory mechanism for the Press to ensure ethical and free reporting. Since then, the Council has played a significant role as an advisory body to the legislature and other authorities and also constantly striving to protect and preserve press freedom and to raise the standards of press in the country.

The Council, every year, on November 16, the day of its establishment, observes this day as the “National Press Day”, which is symbolic of free and responsible Press in India and is so commemorated throughout the country. The main event of National Press Day this year will be observed on November 16, 2023 at the Hall No. 6, Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi from 04:00 p.m onwards and the theme for deliberation is “**Media in the Era of Artificial Intelligence**”.

The Hon’ble Vice-President of India, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar will grace the National Press Day function as the Chief Guest. The Hon’ble Union Minister for Information and Broadcasting and Youth Affairs & Sports, Shri Anurag Singh Thakur and the Hon’ble Union Minister of State for Information and Broadcasting and Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Dr L. Murugan, will be the Guests of Honour, Smt. Justice Ranjana Prakash Desai, Hon’ble Chairperson, Press Council of India will preside over the function and Mr. Amitabh Kant, IAS, G20 Sherpa will be the Keynote Speaker on the theme of the National Press Day function.

We expect participation from Indian Delegates, Senior Officials of Government of India, High Commissioners/Ambassadors of foreign countries in New Delhi, Eminent Journalists, Media experts and students from journalism Institutes.
